



Level 3 Diploma in Clinical Healthcare Support

Are you a HCA working in a GP surgery, Health centre or are you a care worker who would like to develop or validate your clinical skills? Then this is the course for you. The course will underpin your current practice with knowledge, legislation and develop your clinical skills giving you an accredited qualification. Achieving this qualification could also be a stepping stone to a career in nursing or other Health professions.

What will I Study?

Mandatory Units covered:

- Engage in personal development in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Promote communication in health, social care or children's and young people's setting
- Promote equality and inclusion in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Promote and implement health and safety in health and social care
- Principles of safeguarding and protection in health and social care
- Promote person centred approaches in health and social care
- The role of the health and social care worker
- Promote good practice in handling information in health and social care settings
- The Principles of Infection Prevention and Control
- Causes and Spread of Infection
- Cleaning, Decontamination and Waste Management
- Principles for implementing duty of care in health, social care or children's and young people's settings

Plus a selection of optional units best suited to your workplace needs.

How will the course be delivered?

- Candidates will attend monthly sessions in college to receive underpinning knowledge, networking opportunities and sharing of good practice. Following the session they will have access to the college library and computer facilities to carry out self directed study, thus taking best advantage of valuable time out of their day to day role.
- Candidates will complete an e portfolio of evidence and have access to resources and support specific to their course via our online Moodle site.
- Each candidate will additionally receive 1:1 visits from a qualified assessor and registered nurse to observe the candidates carrying out their duties and sign them off once fully competent.
- Applicants under 24 years of age who do not already hold a Level 3 qualification or 2 or more A Levels will be fully funded.
- The course will also attract funding for the learner to access via our advanced learner loan for those 19 and above who already hold a Level 3 qualification or 2 or more A Levels.
