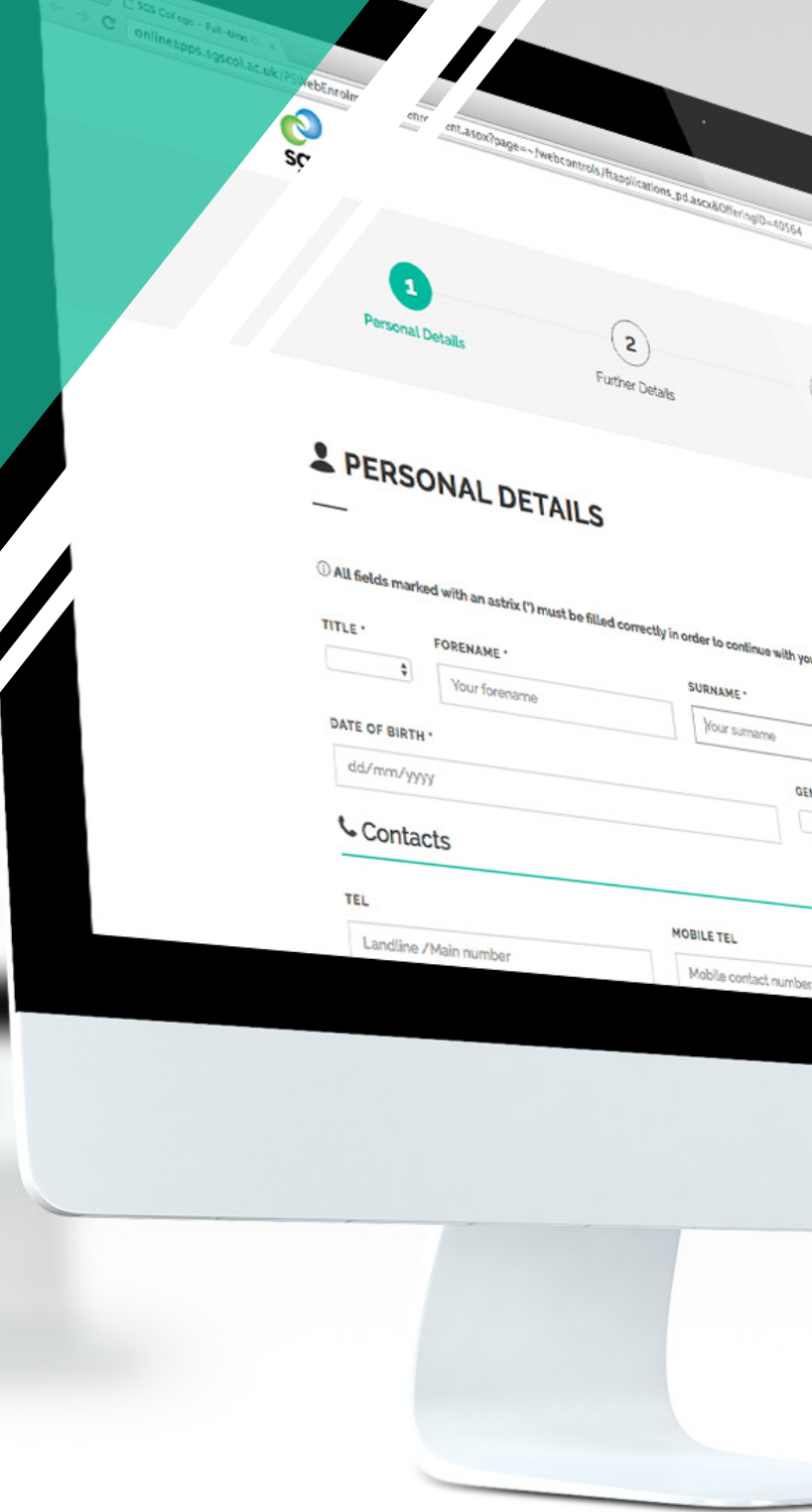

What will I study?

The first year of the Biology course builds on prior knowledge from GCSEs, giving learners a broad yet detailed approach to the discipline. Learners will build on their knowledge by examining topics such as evolution, photosynthesis, homeostasis and gene technology.

Year 1:

- Module 1 - Development of practical skills in Biology
- Module 2 - Foundations in Biology
- Module 3 - Exchange and transport
- Module 4 - Biodiversity, evolution and disease Year 2:
- Module 5 - Communication, homeostasis and energy
- Module 6 - Genetics, evolution and ecosystems

What do I need to join?

At least 5 full GCSEs grades 9-4 (A*-C), including English Language and Maths, Core and additional Science grades BB or 2 B grades out of the triple sciences.

How long is the course?

2 years.

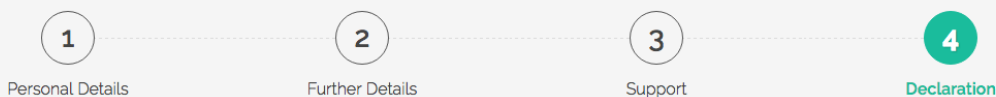
